A Letter from our Pastor

Happy October!

Boo! That's something you'll see in a lot of yards over the next month, and it raises a question. What evokes fear for you?

Seriously. Stop for a moment and think. What are three things that you're afraid of?

When I wrote this article, Deanna was in Bloomsburg for a couple of days watching three of our seven grandchildren. Some of you will understand what I'm about to say, and perhaps others won't, but when you hit my age, the thought will sometimes cross my mind: what would I do if Deanna died? How would I survive? That's something I'm afraid of...her dying first...how am I going to live? Not how am I going to eat or how do you do laundry and the million other things that are part of what she does in our home. How am I going to live, alone?

For some reason I always remember sitting at a lunch after a funeral a couple of decades ago. I was seated across from a widow who I didn't know. She said that sometimes other women would try to comfort her - women who still had their husbands but had experienced some loss in their lives - and they'd say, "I know what just you're going through." She said, "No one knows what it's like until you wake up at 2 in the morning, reach over to the other side of the bed and no one is there." That scares me, because... Maybe because I just don't know what that's going to be like. I'm fearful about how alone I'll feel. How will I handle it? How will I live alone?

There's a lot of people who fear snakes. I have some advice for you. Move to Alaska. You know why? There's no snakes in Alaska. Reptiles can't live there because it's too cold and because for large parts of the year, there's no daylight. Snakes and other reptiles rely on the sun's heat to warm their bodies. So without sun or warm weather, you don't have reptiles.

The problem is that I don't live in Alaska. I live in Pennsylvania. We have rattlesnakes and copperheads here. Yikes! That's my problem with the idea of hiking the Appalachian Trail. I kind of would like the challenge. That'd be a cool thing to do, but what if I see a rattlesnake? You know what would help me? If I had a massively experienced backpacker with me who had absolutely no fear of snakes and could handle them. My fear would be greatly diminished.

Here's what the Bible says. "The Lord is my helper, so I will have no fear." (Hebrews 13:6) When Deanna dies, the Lord is going to be with me. Just like having an experienced hiker going with me on the Appalachian Trail, I have the Lord traveling with me through life and through the experience of the loss of Deanna. That doesn't mean it won't be incredibly, phenomenally hard. I know people who have grieved who have attempted to describe the pain of grief to me. I'm under no delusions. It will hurt, but the Lord is my helper. I do believe he will bring me through that horrible season of my life. I'm putting my trust in him.

And I believe that one day he'll take me to a place very similar to Alaska. It's called heaven. And heaven is a place where, as Alaska doesn't have snakes, heaven has no fear. There is no fear in heaven. Fear can't exist. Not because of the many hours of darkness in heaven, but because of the many hours of light! "And the city has no need of sun or moon, for the glory of God illuminates the city, and the Lamb is its light." (Revelation 21:23) Fear doesn't exist in heaven. And that gives me hope! No matter how difficult life can be, whether my fears come true or not, one day, in heaven, all fear is gone! Because heaven is filled with the light of God's love.

But I do have one final question, just to playfully pull your chain! Some of you like to believe that your pets will be in heaven, that creatures will be in heaven. If that's what you believe, do you also believe snakes will be there too?! Just a question to bring a smile to your face!! Or not!

Fear! Be gone! Jesus is with you, my friends!


Ladies Game Night
