

Early morning and afternoon school buses! Changing leaves! Pumpkin spice everything! It's a special time of year that brings seasonal changes and experiences.

Each week we'll see a creative engaging teaching—about 20 minutes in length—and then process it together. I've seen it really open up and deepen the faith of people and take them further than they've been before.

I want to do this again because its soooo good. It really is. It's a basic introduction to the Christian faith that's extremely well done and will create some good discussion among us. It's also something you could actually use as a tool to share the faith with someone else. Every single video we'll see is available on YouTube. So let's say you actually get to a place where you were sharing your faith with a friend, and you wanted to help them grow deeper. This is a tool you could use. You could watch the video together and process it together. You wouldn't have to study and equip yourself to do something that you find intimidating—this video series would do the heavy lifting! It's really good. And joining us on Wednesdays would give you the confidence to use Alpha personally with others.

I wish everyone would come. To those who have come to Wednesday nights in the past, I hope you join us again in this fall season. I also would love for anyone in our church family who hasn't experienced the Alpha teaching before to join us. Additionally, some of the people who attend The Journey Church at the café are going to attend. Dan's been promoting this for weeks. Our hope is that, eventually, some of the Journey Church individuals would migrate back to Zion's and this Alpha experience is an effort to get some cross pollination of faith experiences involving more seasoned Christians with some young adults who are relatively new to their faith journey. I believe the dynamic among us will be invigorating and unifying. I'm really excited.

For those who have been regular Wednesday night participants, if you have seen Alpha before, and you'd rather do a new teaching, we'll connect with each other on that first Wednesday night. If it's your preference, we can set up an alternative teaching. Whatever is best for you...join us...Wednesday night, September 11 at 6:30 in the church library for a new adventure in our faith journey!

Feeling angry or full of regret? Are you depressed and wondering how to heal? Do you walk around in a mental fog? All this is normal. And while your grief journey is unique, you'll find many grieving people are facing the same struggles. And others who've gone before you can help.

Grief cannot be rushed.

You may wish you could bypass the difficult emotions or push down the pain. Or maybe others are pressuring you to "get up and move on." But healing from grief and loss requires you to go through your grief. We have resources that can help you find relief and stability.

Finding support is crucial.

Grief is a journey that shouldn't be traveled alone. You may feel like no one understands and be tempted to isolate, but as counselor David Bueno Martin says, "Healing happens in the context of finding others who can help you." A GriefShare group is a safe place to find support.


Kids

Z-World

A big thank you to all of you who helped with Z-World—from setting up/tearing down, volunteering during the weekend, baking desserts, donating water, inviting friends, and praying for the event—it could not have happened without you. Many seeds were planted and here are a few highlights of what God did through Z-World:

- Real connections and relationships were made with the families. We visited with every person there.
- Some of the kids and their parents were in a church for the first time in their lives.
- Randy led one parent to Christ.
- Several parents expressed a desire to talk with Randy more in the future about spiritual questions they have.
- I spoke with several adults who went to a church or VBS program as a child and, while at Z-World, felt like they should get connected to a church. They made plans to come back again to Zion's on a typical Sunday.
- We were able to provide sign language interpretation during the program for a family with a child who is deaf. They were extremely blessed by this. On Sunday, one of our regular attenders who is deaf connected with this child in a meaningful way that blessed both her and the boy.
- Several families I talked to who also came last year or to other family events said they watch the service online regularly.
- A couple of families who did not previously attend on a Sunday were in church in the weeks following Z-World.
