"What are you going to do when you retire?" That's the question I get asked frequently.


The most truthful concise answer: Have fun!

WHAT ABOUT GIVING?

Zion's Church offers several ways to donate to the ongoing operations of the Church. From dropping checks/cash into the offering box, using member designated offering envelopes, to Realm online giving. While Realm online giving puts giving right in your hands allowing you to set up recurring gifts, view your giving history, and make changes at any time, it does come at a cost to Zion's Church. We have been notified that the fees for processing credit card transactions have been increased reducing the amount of your contribution to Zion's Church by 3-5%. We do recognize that the amount and method of giving is very personal to you and encourage you to review your method of giving. If giving online is the right method for you, you may want to consider using a checking/savings account versus a credit card as these transactions process at a minimal cost to Zion's Church without the added 3-5% credit card transaction fees.


